Hemoglobin is suggested once after beginning menses in adolescent girls.

Vision screening at ages 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 10, 12, 15 and 18 years

Hearing screening at ages 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10 years

*Discuss and administer Hepatitis A, Varivax booster, HPV vaccine and Menactra and Meningitis B at appropriate age. Ask about risk for tuberculosis exposure and test accordingly. Catch up on any missed or late immunizations.

Universal lipid screening once between age 9-11 years and 17-21 years.
